



## DO YOU HAVE MODERATE PLAQUE PSORIASIS?

Dr. Pearl E. Grimes, Medical Director of the Vitiligo & Pigmentation Institute of Southern California, is a nationally and internationally recognized dermatologist known for her work on pigmentary disorders. The institute is conducting a 16-week research study to investigate the efficacy and safety of Autonomic Nerve Modulation (ANM) in subjects that are 18 years or older with moderate plaque psoriasis.

### QUALIFIED PARTICIPANTS MUST:

- **BE** 18 years of age or older
- **HAVE** plaques on less than 10% of their body
- **BE** diagnosed with chronic plaque psoriasis at least 6 months prior to screening
- **NOT** have Non-plaque psoriasis (erythrodermic or pustular), guttate, inverse psoriatic arthritis, or drug induced psoriasis.
- **NOT** have plaque psoriasis on palms and soles, or the back of the neck, at enrollment
- **NOT** have evidence of other skin conditions other than psoriasis or any other health condition that may interfere with the research study
- **NOT** have a pacemaker, or any type of metal implant in the neck or upper back
- **NOT** have received oral, biologic, photochemotherapy, or phototherapy treatment for their psoriasis recently
